- 4.3 Planting Unit Source The source material for all planting units delivered under this bid must be identified and approved by the owner. All plants must be entirely suitable for the site and use intended.

The Contractor will be required to provide written documentation with the Work Plan as to the source of the planting units delivered under this Bid. Documentation shall include collection permits or contracts from a State, the U.S. Department of Agriculture, or other comparable documents. Bids submitted without this documentation will not be considered.

- 4.4 Required Number of Fencing/Planting Units The approximate number of fencing/planting units to be installed is 1,195 (base bid). The selected Contractor shall provide all fencing/planting units required for the project. Site conditions may dictate adjustments to the number of units estimated for the work site. The final Contract quantities actually placed and accepted may vary from the Bid estimated quantities by $\pm 20\%$. The unit price costs submitted with this bid will be used to determine either add or deduct cost amounts for the project. The Engineer will determine the final number of units accepted as planting units eligible for payment.

- 4.5 Liners and Potted Plant Germination. Potted plants shall have a fully developed root ball that is consistent with the size of the specified container, but is not root-bound, at the time of delivery. All foundation dune plant materials grown in multi-well trays (liners) and prepared
