An expression of what you want to be and achieve in the future. A vision to build on current strengths, provide inspiration, and challenge the current situation.


- What do we want to achieve in the future?

- The meeting was called to order at 2:06 PM.
- Taylor Ladd opened the meeting with a recap of the photograph activity from the last meeting with a review of the themes that came out of the activity being used for today's activity.
- Taylor Ladd introduced the Attribute Activity. Using the worksheet provided with the group's themes, group members were asked to think of an excellent idea or example for Hilton Head pertaining to each theme.
- Group members completed the attribute worksheet and had a discussion around the Commerce, Education and Infrastructure: Transpiration themes.
- The results gleaned from the group's worksheets for this activity are as follows:

Commerce Examples and Ideas of Excellence Opportunities for HHI
