- Jayme Lopko started discussion with the work group on the Community Facilities Element from the current Comprehensive Plan. The work group discussed the following topics: technology to stay relevant, placing housing near transportation, connecting the island to Bluffton by pathway, travel demand management, education on existing public transportation, using Town as example for incentives by employers, location living preference study, utility infrastructure equity across the region, simplifying regulatory policies, and gaps in trade school/college education.
