BUILDING PLAN REVIEW MINIMUM SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

_____ 2 complete sets of plans **to scale** (hard copy) and 1 digital copy (The digital copy can be submitted via email to CDIC@hiltonheadislandsc.gov, either as a pdf attachment if the file size is 10MB or less, or with a link to a dropbox) showing a minimum of:

- The location, nature and extent of the work proposed and show in detail that it will conform to the provisions of the locally adopted Codes, ordinances and rules and regulations of the Town and State.
- Site plan showing existing and proposed structures, lot acreage, impervious/pervious coverage, setbacks and buffers, and elevations showing setback angles and height measured from the BFE, the OCRM Critical Line and the Town's Beachfront Line, Transition Area and Coastal Protection Area Overlays (when applicable).
- **Tree protection fencing delineated and labeled along the edge of all required buffers**
- Dimensioned floor plans.
- Plans of all mechanical, electrical and plumbing work.
- Structural plans showing at a minimum, foundations, wall sections and loads (including calculations).
- Detail the location, construction, size and character of all portions of the means of egress.

_____ Commercial plans must be to scale and stamped by an architect or engineer when:

- The building is over 5000 square feet in size.
- Over two stories in height.
- The occupancy classification falls into Group A, E, H or I.

_____ Certified copy of the 'Under Construction' Flood Elevation Certificate is required prior to vertical construction above the first habitable floor in A & V zones. An original Finished Construction Flood Elevation Certificate is required prior to a Certificate of Occupancy for building located in A & V zones.

_____ Zone Certification is required for all buildings located in a velocity zone.

_____ Pool/Spa Sq Ft: _____ (will require a separate building permit)

_____ Elevation of Pool Deck: _____ (will require a separate building permit)

_____ Mechanical Certificates from Plumbing, Electric, & Mechanic Contractors

My signature hereto signifies I am the owner and or contractor responsible for job site compliance as outlined in the Land Management Ordinance 16-5-109. - Stormwater Management and Erosion and Sedimentation Control Standards

1. Installation and regular maintenance of silt fencing using DHEC Standard of trenching installation on all low/down slope side of the job site. Silt fence is to have an upslope return at each end no less than 5 ft; and
2. Installation and regular maintenance of stone construction entrance. Stone construction entrance shall consist of a 2 inch to 3 inch coarse aggregate stone. Construction entrance shall be a minimum of 6 inches in thickness, 15 foot wide and extend to the structure or a minimum of 20 feet in length; and
3. Removal of sediment from the street or adjacent property(ies) within (48 hrs) following such an occurrence; and
4. Conduct no land disturbing activity within 20 feet of a wetland, lagoon, beach, or other water body; and
5. Provide temporary vegetation and/or mulch on any exposed areas to provide an effective barrier from erosion within 14 days of inactivity; and
6. Install any other best management measures as deemed necessary by the Town of Hilton Head Island.
7. All construction site activities must adhere to the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) General Permit SC001000.

I understand that if the disturbed area for any reason becomes greater than 21,780 square feet and/or within ½ mile of a Coastal Receiving Water as defined by SCDHEC, a formal Stormwater Management Plan (SWPPP) will be required to be submitted to the town for review and approval. I further acknowledge the Town’s Building Inspectors may refuse to conduct building inspections and the Town may issue Notices of Violation, Stop Work Orders, and/or Civil Penalties for failure to comply with the sediment and erosion control requirements.
