The Hilton Head Pickleball Association as well as residents of Hilton Head Island addressed the Commissioners on the need for dedicated pickleball courts. Recently the basketball courts at Chaplin have been striped to convert them for pickleball. A schedule will need to be set to reserve those basketball courts for pickleball use and appropriate signage will need to be put up.
